Rockrimmon Break-ins

As many of you have heard, Rockrimmon has had a series of car break-ins. It appears these offenders are targeting people with items left in their vehicles in plain view. I've attached a summary of the vehicle break-ins in the Rockrimmon area on page two of this newsletter.

Unfortunately we treat our vehicles as an extension of our living room and sometimes store items that are very attractive to criminals. A stack of CD's or an Ipod represents some "quick cash" to a criminal. They don't care that they have just caused \$200 worth of damage to the window.

On that note, with summer fast upon us, bicycles become easy targets for criminals. It's a good idea to write down the serial number of your bike and keep on file.

Bike Safety

- Strongly encourage kids to wear a helmet
- Be sure your bike is adjusted to fit. The bike should be the correct size.
- Be sure all equipment works well. (Especially the brakes)
- Encourage kids to ride in control.
- Encourage kids to avoid riding at night.

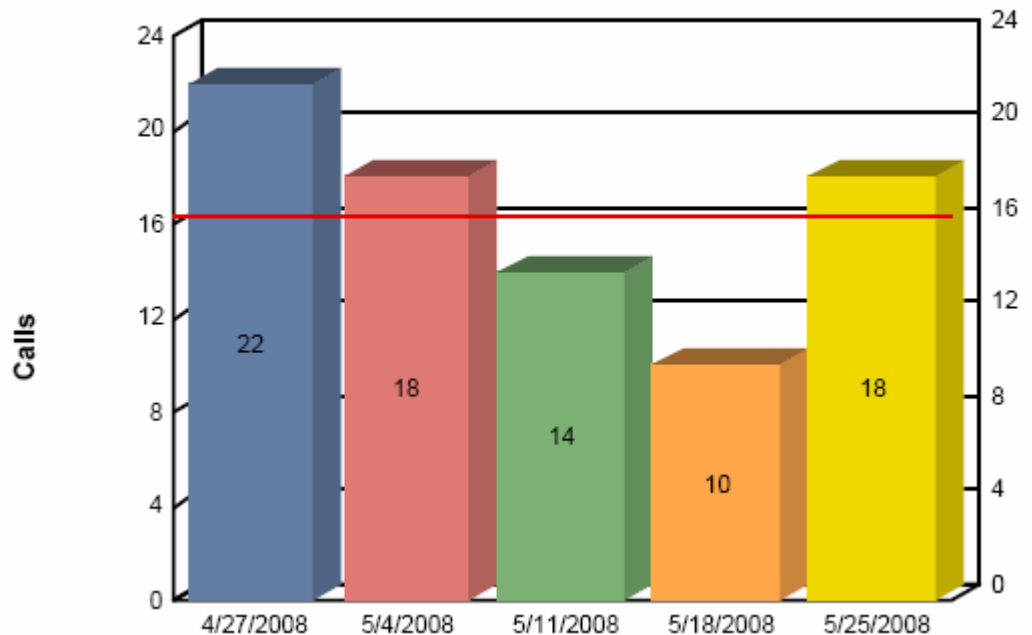
