I think it is very important to let our fellow homeowners know what happened to us this last week. We are David and Diana Fruh at 20 Gold Coin Court. On Sunday, June 28th our home was broken into while we were sleeping. We had left a window open on the main level. The burglars pulled the screen off and climbed through. Our cell phones, David's wallet, and my keys were stolen. The police were able to get some fingerprints off of the screen but we haven't heard of any leads yet. They also said that it is very rare for people to come in during the night when you are at home. Currently Rockrimmon and the Broadmoor area are being targeted for burglaries and home invasions.

Since our keys were stolen, we had a locksmith rekey our doors as well as our cars. We also installed a security system through ADT by Vaso Bjegovich. The police gave us an update on the manhunt that occurred on Saturday, June 27th. Some of you know (and heard) that evening, several police cars on Rockrimmon Blvd as well as the police helicopter. Later there were teams of police with the K-9 units searching along Gold Coin and Mikado. Anyway, the police officer on our case said that they caught the guy. He was pulled over in a stolen truck and then he ran. The police found a bunch of identity theft information in the truck. Also, when we went to the AT&T store to replace our phones, the sale guy mentioned that he lived in Raven Crest Townhomes (near the intersection of Rockrimmon Blvd and Woodmen on the south side of Rockrimmon). We told him what had happened to our phones and he said that he was the one who called the police on Saturday because there were people in his complex trying to steal cars. We then informed him that the guy had been caught.
